Showers concocted a Paris-meets-Park Avenue lair, a cream-colored two-bedroom unit propped with French '40s glamour, Murano chandeliers and blonde cowhide rugs. Varney went GQ/cowboy, splashing his one-bedroom pad with vermilion red paint, then stirring in dark-wood furnishings, a Remington bronze and black-and-white photography. As for number three? We can't wait to see what the versatile, vivacious Hunt pulls off — she's as adept at Manhattan apartments as she is at mountain lodges, and is finishing her model as we type.
